Spacing and Location of Fire Sprinklers: NFPA 13, Ch. 8 (2016 Ed.)

The basic installation rules for spacing and location of all types of sprinklers can be found in NFPA 13, Chapter 8. These rules have experienced many changes over the course of recent editions making it critical to keep up with the latest requirements. This seminar is designed to help participants gain a greater level of understanding of the structure of the chapter and increase their ability to navigate and apply the data provided in the chapter along with related definitions provided in Chapter 3. Sprinkler system designers as well as estimators, project managers, installers, inspectors, specifying engineers, and AHJs will all benefit from this seminar. Upon completion, participants should be able to analyze building conditions; generate shop drawings; identify sprinkler system design criteria related to selection of sprinkler types; interpret and apply rules for spacing & location of various types of sprinklers; explain rules related to sprinkler temperature classification and use of higher temperature sprinklers installed near heat sources; review and apply the rules for obstruction avoidance; identify definitions and rules for sprinkler installation near cloud ceilings; and explain the rules for venting of wet pipe systems.

NFPA 13 (2016 Ed.): Storage Occupancies

This course is a hands-on examination of storage occupancies as defined in the 2016 edition of NFPA 13, and requires an understanding of sprinkler systems and basic layout principles. It includes a review of the organization of the standard in relation to storage definitions, classification of storage commodities, and how to locate and apply the requirements for storage protection. Attendees will complete exercises to determine protection criteria for a number of storage arrangements and commodities. Learning objectives for this course include: explain the organization of chapters related to storage; classify commodities; find and apply definitions of storage terms; and locate and apply storage requirements. This seminar benefits contractors, engineers, layout technicians, and AHJs.
